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4 **RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 8134**

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6 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr.,
7 authorizing Lateral Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project No. T-
8 401011.00 (HTE #409670) which provides for providing sewer
9 service to part of Kaw Half-Breed Reserve No. 2 as more
10 specifically described herein.

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12 WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a01, *et*
13 *seq.*, as amended, containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the
14 improvement district hereinafter described; and

15 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
17 Kansas, that it finds Lateral Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project No. T-401011.00 (HTE
18 #409670), hereinafter described, to be advisable and does hereby authorize and order said
19 improvement to be made in accordance with its findings as follows:

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21 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

22 To provide sanitary sewer service to the following described area with piping,
23 manholes, engineering and all other contingencies required for a complete
24 project.
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27 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

28 Part of Kaw Half-Breed Reserve No. 2 described as:
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30 Beginning 60 feet south and 10 feet west of the NE corner of Furman Road
31 and Lower Silver Lake Road; thence east 132 feet; thence south 204 feet
32 (scaled); thence northwest 138 feet; thence north 165 feet (scaled) to the
33 Point of Beginning.

36 C. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

37 \$22,728.00
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39 D. PROPOSED METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

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41 On a unit basis for the one lot or individual dwelling site known as 3249 NW
42 Lower Silver Lake Road, that is included in the described improvement
43 district.

45 E. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:

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47 \$100% of costs are to be paid by the owners of the property within the
48 Improvement District.
