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3 **RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 8166**

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5 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr.,
6 authorizing Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project No. T-
7 401014.00 (HTE #409700) which provides for sanitary sewer
8 service in the Cedar Crest Office Park Subdivision as more
9 specifically described herein.

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11 WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a01, *et*
12 *seq.*, as amended, containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the
13 improvement district hereinafter described; and

14 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY of the City of
16 Topeka, Kansas, that it finds Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project No. T-401014.00 (HTE
17 #409700), hereinafter described, to be advisable and does hereby authorize and order said
18 improvement to be made in accordance with its findings as follows:

19 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

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21 To provide sanitary sewer service to the described area with piping,
22 manholes, and all other contingencies required for a complete project.

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24 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

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26 *Cedar Crest Office Park Subdivision*
27 Lots 1 through 11

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29 C. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

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31 \$210,150.00

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33 D. PROPOSED METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

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35 On a unit basis for all lots or individual dwelling sites which are included in
36 the described improvement district, with units described as follows:

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38 1 Unit Each for Lots 1, 2, 4 through 11
39 2 Units for Lot 3

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E. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:

Costs are to be paid 100% by the owners of the property within the Improvement District.

Upon completion of the project described herein, the City Clerk is hereby directed to provide all publication and mailed notices in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 12-6a01, *et seq.*, as amended.

THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon one publication in the official city newspaper.
