3 **RESOLUTION NO. 8224**

5 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., setting forth the
6 City of Topeka's NOTICE OF INTENT to issue general obligation bonds
7 to acquire fire-fighting equipment, specifically an aerial ladder truck, all
8 pursuant to K.S.A. 12-110c.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the ~~Council~~ Governing Body of the City
11 of Topeka, Kansas, that it is necessary to replace a 1976 aerial ladder truck utilized for fire
12 suppression activities due to the current truck's unreliability and extremely high
13 maintenance costs; and the ~~Council~~ Governing Body of the City of Topeka hereby
14 authorizes purchase of an aerial ladder truck funded by general obligation bonds in an
15 amount not to exceed one million three hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$1,360,000.00).

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the ~~Council~~ Governing Body of the City of Topeka,
17 that it hereby declares its NOTICE OF INTENT to issue general obligation bonds of the
18 City of Topeka in the total amount of one million three hundred sixty thousand dollars
19 (\$1,360,000.00) for the purpose of acquiring an aerial ladder truck.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the ~~Council~~ Governing Body of the City of Topeka,
21 Kansas, that this Resolution upon its adoption by the ~~Council~~ Governing Body shall
22 constitute the City's Notice of Intention to issue general obligation bonds.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the ~~Council~~ Governing Body of the City of Topeka,
24 Kansas, that the City Clerk shall cause this Resolution to be published once a week for two
25 consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper, providing NOTICE OF INTENT pursuant
26 to K.S.A. 12-110c. Unless written protests against this Resolution and Notice signed by
27 not less than five percent (5%) of the qualified electors of the City are filed with the City
28 Clerk within sixty (60) days after the publication of this Notice, issuance of general
29 obligation bonds are authorized as stated herein.
