3 **RESOLUTION NO. 8232**

5 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr. authorizing  
6 initiation of condemnation proceedings to acquire permanent sanitary  
7 sewer and temporary construction easements for construction of the  
8 Southwest Interceptor, Project No. T-401009.00, to extend the sanitary  
9 sewer coverage into the area southwest of Topeka.

11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Topeka, Kansas, pursuant  
12 to K.S.A. 26-201 that it is necessary and advisable in the public interest to condemn certain  
13 private property interests for the public purposes of the construction of a sanitary sewer  
14 main known as the Southwest Interceptor to extend the sanitary sewer coverage into the  
15 area southwest of Topeka and such other public purposes as are authorized by law.

16 Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 26-201, the Engineering Division is hereby  
17 authorized and directed to cause a survey to be made by some competent engineer of  
18 those private lands which are necessary to be appropriated for the improvements, and such  
19 other public purposes as are authorized by law, and the City Engineer, or her designee, is  
20 authorized and directed to file the report of the survey, including a description of those  
21 private lands and interests to be acquired by condemnation, in the office of the City Clerk.

22 THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon one publication in the official city  
23 newspaper.
