3 **RESOLUTION NO. 8234**

5 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr. authorizing  
6 initiation of condemnation proceedings to acquire permanent public  
7 utility easements for the following public purposes: drainage, water line,  
8 storm sewer and sanitary sewer; as well as permanent public right-of-  
9 way easement; temporary construction easements; and fee simple  
10 interest to widen SW 29<sup>th</sup> Street to five (5) lanes between SW  
11 Wanamaker Road and SW Urish Road and construct a new roundabout  
12 at SW Urish Road intersection and the relocation of the waterline,  
13 Project No. 70204-01.

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Topeka, Kansas, pursuant  
16 to K.S.A. 26-201 that it is necessary and advisable in the public interest to condemn in and  
17 outside the corporate limits of the City of Topeka certain private property interests for the  
18 public purposes including permanent public utility easements for the following public  
19 purposes: drainage, water line, storm sewer and sanitary sewer; as well as permanent  
20 public right-of-way easement; temporary construction easements; and fee simple interest to  
21 widen SW 29<sup>th</sup> Street to five (5) lanes between SW Wanamaker Road and SW Urish Road  
22 and construct a new roundabout at SW Urish Road intersection and the relocation of the  
23 waterline and such other public purposes as are authorized by law.

24 Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 26-201, the Engineering Division is hereby  
25 authorized and directed to cause a survey to be made by some competent engineer of  
26 those private lands which are necessary to be appropriated for the improvements, and such  
27 other public purposes as are authorized by law, and the City Engineer, or her designee, is  
28 authorized and directed to file the report of the survey, including a description of those  
29 private lands and interests to be acquired by condemnation, in the office of the City Clerk.

31 THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon one publication in the official city  
32 newspaper.
