

1 **RESOLUTION NO. 8303**

3 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., amending the
4 Project Budget for Improvement Project No. T-301014.00 (HTE #
5 302930) which provides for the property acquisition and site
6 preparation for the Great Overland Station Park development and
7 rescinding City of Topeka Resolution No. 8201.
8

9 WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Topeka adopted Resolution No. 8201 on
10 September 22, 2009, which authorized Improvement Project No. T-301014.00 (HTE #
11 302930) (the Project) which provided for the property acquisition and site preparation for
12 the Great Overland Station Park development; and

13 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 8201 established a Project Budget of two hundred
14 eighty-four thousand (\$284,000.00) to be paid from Transient Guest Tax funds; and

15 WHEREAS, the City has the opportunity to acquire additional property which
16 requires the Project Budget to be increased.

17 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka that it
18 finds the following described public improvement to be necessary and in the public interest
19 and does hereby authorize Improvement Project No. T-301014.00 (HTE # 302930) as
20 hereinafter described:

22 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:
23

24 This project will provide property acquisition and site preparation for the
25 Great Overland Station Park development, located south of NW Curtis Street
26 to the Kansas River between N Kansas Avenue and NW Tyler Street. This
27 project will include structure demolition and clearing; property acquisition; site
28 preparation; environmental and geotechnical studies; alley, road and
29 easement vacation; removal of curb, gutter and road surface and other
30 appurtenances as needed to complete the project.
