

RESOLUTION NO. 8325

A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember Sylvia Ortiz in support of Christians for Life, Inc.'s application for tax exemption status from the Court of Tax Appeals of the State of Kansas for the Heart of America Memorial Wall for the Unborn.

WHEREAS, Christians for Life, Inc. has beautified the previously vacant lot at 1216 SE Republican, located just east of the Mount Auburn Cemetery, by erecting a black granite marker in honor of children whose lives ended prematurely either through miscarriage, stillbirth or abortion. The installation of lighting, sidewalks, semicircle drive of lamp lights and planted flowers has created a garden area that provides a sense of peace and calmness for those who visit.
