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6 A RESOLUTION introduced by Daniel R. Stanley, Acting City Manager,
7 authorizing Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project No. T-
8 401026.00 which provides for sewer service for Horseshoe
9 Bend Subdivision Nos. 2 and 3 as more specifically described
10 herein.
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12 WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a01, *et*
13 *seq.*, as amended, containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the
14 improvement district hereinafter described; and

15 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of
17 Topeka, Kansas, that it finds Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project No. T-401026.00,
18 hereinafter described, to be advisable and does hereby authorize and order said
19 improvement to be made in accordance with its findings as follows:

20 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:
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22 To provide sanitary sewer service to the following described area with piping,
23 manholes, engineering and all other contingencies required for a complete
24 project.
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26 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:
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28 *Horseshoe Bend Subdivision No. 2*

29 Block A, Lots 3 through 7
30 Block B; Lots 1 through 19
31 Block C; Lots 1 through 8
32 Block D; Lot 1
33 Block E; Lots 1 through 6
34 Block F; Lots 1 through 11

35 *Horseshoe Bend Subdivision No. 3*

36 Block A, Lots 1 through 3
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C. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

\$353,270.00

D. PROPOSED METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

On a unit basis for all lots which are included in the improvement district.
(53 Lots, 1 Unit per Lot)

E. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:

100 % by the owners of the property within the Improvement District.

Upon completion of the project described herein, the City Clerk is hereby directed to provide all publication and mailed notices in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 12-6a01, *et seq.*, as amended.

THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon one publication in the official city newspaper.
