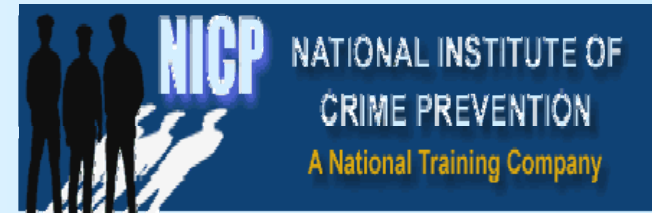

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED), is based upon the principle that “the proper design and effective use of the built environment can lead to a reduction in the fear and incidence of crime, and the improvement in the quality of life.”

WHO SHOULD ATTEND THIS SEMINAR?

CPTED strategies are ideal for Law Enforcement Officers, City Planners, City Managers, City Council Members, Architects, Traffic Engineers, Security Consultants, Educators or anyone involved in designing neighborhoods, schools, downtown, or buildings. It is an effective way of fighting crime and promoting business.

Cities and Counties throughout the country are adopting CPTED ordinances requiring site plan reviews with crime prevention in mind. Law enforcement officers who are specially trained in CPTED are now working closely with Planners, Architects, City Officials, and Educators to ensure the proper design of structures, schools, and neighborhoods.

Participants will learn how the design and use of the environment can control human / criminal behavior and reduce fear of crime. Participants will learn the advantages of having a CPTED Ordinance and how to construct and present it to lawmakers.

Law Enforcement agencies should be involved in the preplanning of any community activity where their services will later be required.

BASIC CPTED SEMINAR

The 5-day Basic CPTED Seminar will be held March 8th — 12th, 2010, at the Law Enforcement Center (320 S. Kansas Ave. STE 100 Topeka, Kansas). This seminar will focus upon basic CPTED skills and knowledge required by law enforcement officers & persons involved in community planning activities. The primary topic areas to be addressed in the Basic CPTED Seminar are outlined on the reverse side of this brochure.

The cost of attending the Basic CPTED Seminar is \$350. This includes registration fee, extensive hand-out materials, and refreshment breaks. The fee does not include travel, lodging or other food expenses.
