Our campers can experience traditional (and some non-traditional) day camp activities presented in an ability and age appropriate manner. ## Dates & Themes

**May 31 – June 3\*: Moving & Grooving-** Jump into a hip week filled with music & movement. We'll work together to create an extreme obstacle course, learn far out dance moves, make groovy tie-dye shirts, build your own instrument, & have a be-there-or-be-square dance party! \*No camp Monday, May 30

**June 6-10: Hawaiian Hullabaloo-** Surf into summer! Campers will do the limbo rock, create surf boards, and make Hawaiian leis and seashell art. Campers will also learn how to hula and keep the beat on their own homemade drums. After learning about how islands and volcanoes are formed, campers will even make volcanoes and watch them erupt with lava.

**Meets: 2 weeks, 6.5 hours per day, Monday-Friday with late pick-up option available.**

The camp is designed for youth ages 8-17 (ages 18-20 if enrolled in school for fall 2011) who have a developmental delay or an emotional, cognitive, and/or physical disability, which requires adapted instruction and supervision. Other activities include: swimming, arts and crafts, field trips, fitness, music and nature. Our activities and educational experiences are presented in an ability and age appropriate manner. Partial

scholarships are available in cooperation with the Topeka Civitan Club.

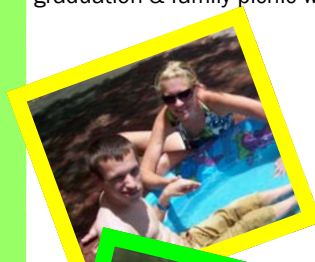
## Dates & Themes
