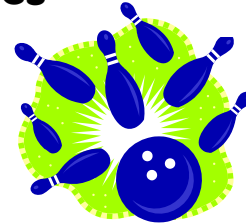




Bowling (Ten Pin)

KSO2011 Entry Regulations:

1. Competitors are encouraged to bring their own bowling balls and shoes; however, house balls and shoes will be available at the competitor's expense.
2. Bowlers must pay regular lane fees at the event site in addition to the regular KSO entry fee. (\$6 per event)
3. Partners must each designate the other on their entry forms. No partners will be assigned, and no partner changes may be made after the entry deadline.
4. The age division for competition for KSO2011 for doubles and mixed doubles will be determined by the age of the younger of the two partners as of December 31, 2011.

KSO2011 Format:

1. All formats will be scratch.
2. Bowlers will be divided into squads by age division for each bowling event.
3. Bowling times and lanes will be assigned by squad. These assignments will be posted at the event site on the day of play.
4. Singles, doubles, and mixed doubles will bowl one set of three games.
5. The scratch scores will determine awards.
