KSO 2009 Entry Regulations:

1. Athletes must provide their own racquets. Balls will be provided.
2. Partners must each designate the other on their entry form. No partners will be assigned and no partner changes may be made after the entry deadline.
3. The age division of competition for doubles and mixed doubles for KSO 2009 will be determined by the age of the younger of the two partners as of December 31, 2009.

KS02009 Format:

1. If numbers are conducive, athletes will be divided into pools within their age division. Within each pool, a single round-robin tournament will be played. At the conclusion of the round-robin, winners will advance and play a single elimination tournament. If entries are not conducive, a double elimination tournament will be played within the age divisions. Winners will be determined within each age division.

KS02009 Sport Rules:

1. All matches will be conducted in accordance with United States Racquetball Association (USRA) rules, except as modified herein. For a copy of these rules, contact:

2. Lensed eye-wear designed for racquet sports is mandatory.
3. Matches will be best of three games, with the first two games to 15. Third game tiebreakers will be played to 11.
4. Competition must take place to determine winners. If there is only one individual entered in an age division, that individual must complete the event to receive the gold medal. That individual will be placed with the closest age division to compete with—but not against—those athletes. Hence, there may be two gold medals awarded in such an event, and the win/loss record will not be considered.
5. All entrants must check in with the Racquetball coordinator on site by 30 minutes prior to tournament start time.
6. First matches will begin promptly at 9 a.m. Subsequent matches will begin as soon as courts become available. This will facilitate the completion of competition.
7. Each participant will be expected to referee a subsequent match.

Conduct of Racquetball Players:

Good sportsmanlike conduct is required of Racquetball Players at all times. Any Racquetball Player displaying less-than-desirable conduct at any time towards another Racquetball Player, any meet official, any volunteer or any KSO staff member will be disqualified from KSO competition. The KSO Director and Event Coordinators will enforce this rule at all times.
