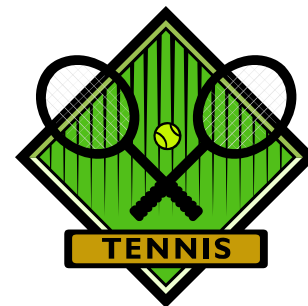

KSO2009 Entry Regulations:

1. Athletes must provide their own racquets and practice balls. Competition balls will be provided.
2. Athletes may enter Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles events in KSO2009. Those entering doubles events must designate their partners on their entry forms. No partners will be assigned. Athletes may compete with only one partner per sporting event.
3. For doubles events, the age of the youngest partner as of December 31, 2009, determines the age category for competition in KSO2009.

KSO2009 Format:

1. The format for Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles will be a single-elimination tournament.

KSO2009 Sport Rules:

1. All tennis matches will be conducted in accordance with United States Tennis Association (USTA) rules except as modified herein. 2. The tournament will be played outdoors on hard surface courts. Tennis balls to be used will be of a type designated for hard court play.
3. There will be a one-minute break every two games.
4. Matches shall consist of two sets using regular scoring. Ties will be broken using a “super” tie-breaker except as may be modified in accordance with Format, Item 3.
5. Competition must take place to determine qualifiers. If there is only one individual/team entered in an age division, the individual/team must complete the event to receive the gold medal. That individual/team will be placed with the closest age division to compete with—but not against—those athletes. Hence, there may be two gold medals awarded in such an event, and the win-loss record will not be considered.

Conduct of Tennis Players: Good sportsmanlike conduct is required of Tennis Players at all times. Any Tennis Player displaying less-than-desirable conduct at any time towards another Tennis Player, any meet official, any volunteer or any KSO staff member will be disqualified from KSO competition. The KSO Director and Event Coordinators will enforce this rule at all times.
