KSO 2009 Entry Regulations:

1. Age division for all competition will be determined by the age of the youngest team member as of December 31, 2009.
2. Team rosters shall be limited to 15 persons, including non-playing coaches, non-playing captains, and non-playing bench personnel, with a maximum of four out-of-state residents, except as permitted by Rule F of the Qualifying Procedures and Rules governing the 2009 Summer National Senior Games—Senior Olympics. Roster changes shall be allowed only as permitted under Rule F.
3. All registration and team rules apply to non-playing coaches, non-playing captains, and non-playing bench personnel.
4. Athletes may compete with only one team per sport.

KSO2009 Format:

1. If numbers are conducive, teams will be divided into pools within their age groups. Within each pool, a single round-robin tournament will be played. At the conclusion of the round-robin, winners will advance and play a single-elimination tournament. If entries are not conducive, a double elimination tournament will be played within the age group.
2. In age groups where single teams are entered, that team will be given exhibition opportunities with the closest age group. A single team entry will be an automatic winner and will not detract from the record of any opposing team in another age group.
3. Net height shall be in accordance with USA Volleyball rules. In men's 50-54 competition, the net height will be 7'11 5/8". In Men's 55+ and up competition, net height will be 7'9 5/8". In all women's competition, the net height will be 7'2 1/8".

KSO2009 Sport Rules:

1. All matches will be conducted in accordance with USA Volleyball (USAV) rules. For a copy of these rules, contact: **U.S. Volleyball, 715 South Circle Dr. Colorado Springs, Co. 80910 (719) 228-6800 www.usavolleyball.org**
2. Team clothing must be of like design and color. It is recommended that team shirts be numbered both on the front and back.
3. A team must have at least 5 players present to start a game, otherwise the game is forfeited. A 5-minute grace period will be allowed to assemble a minimum of 5 players. The 6th player may enter upon arrival. In the event of injury, a team may continue/finish with a minimum of 4 players on the floor.
4. Teams competing with only five players shall always have three players on the front row. No service rotation penalty shall be assessed for not having six players.
5. To win a match, a team must win two out of three games.
6. In round-robin play, USA Volleyball rules governing tie-breakers will be used.
7. No black-soled shoes will be permitted on the gym floor. Balls will be provided.

Conduct of Volleyball Players:

Good sportsmanlike conduct is required of Volleyball Players at all times. Any Volleyball Player displaying less-than-desirable conduct at any time towards another Volleyball Player, any meet official, any volunteer or any KSO staff member will be disqualified from KSO competition. The KSO Director and Event Coordinators will enforce this rule at all times.
