

NOTICE OF TRAFFICWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NO. 70204-01

SW 29TH Street From SW Urish Road to SW Wanamaker Road

The reconstruction and widening project on SW 29th Street from SW Urish Road to SW Wanamaker Road will begin on March 17, 2010.

The project will include:

- Five-lanes of asphalt pavement with concrete curb and gutter
- An underground storm sewer system to collect storm water runoff
- Walkways on both sides of SW 29th Street (five feet wide on the north side and eight feet wide on the south side)
- A larger roundabout at the SW Urish Road intersection
- A new traffic signal at the SW Wanamaker Road intersection
- Street lighting

The project will be built over two years. All properties adjacent to the project will have at least one point of access to them at all times during construction. Access to properties may require the use of detour routes or temporary roads and driveways. Some entrances and side roads will need to be constructed one half at a time.

During the first year of construction in 2010, SW 29th Street between SW Tallgrass Drive and SW Kingsrow Road will be under construction. In order to build the roundabout and the new drainage structures between SW Urish Road and SW Kingsrow Road, it will be necessary to make full roadway closures. To accommodate area businesses and residents, construction will be broken into multiple phases (See Year 2010 Details). When each phase is completed, the roadway will be re-opened to traffic. Through traffic on SW 29th Street and SW Urish Road will be carried on detours during roadway closures.

During 2010, there may be some lane restrictions between SW Kingsrow Road and SW Wanamaker Road for utility relocation work, temporarily widening on the south side, and drainage work in preparation for phasing of construction in 2011. During 2011, SW 29th Street between SW Kingsrow Road and SW Wanamaker Road will be constructed one half at a time. It is anticipated that traffic will be carried through construction adjacent to the work zone in 2011.

The project is funded by the County-wide Half Cent Sales Tax. The sales tax projects were approved by Shawnee County voters in August 2004.
