Passport to Adventure is located in Crestview Park just west of the Crestview Community Center and is licensed by the State of Kansas. All participants will be required to have a completed Health History Form and an Emergency Care Form in order to attend the licensed program. Campers will need to bring daily: Swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, lunch and a drink, in a cooler (refrigeration is not available). Two nutritional snacks, beverages and admission to special trips and tours is included in the fee.

OPTION I (\$118.75; \$95 per week Topeka resident). Campers may be brought to the Crestview Shelter House after 7:15 am and picked up NO LATER than 5:30pm There is NO BUS TRANSPORTATION FOR THIS CAMP. See Parent Handbook for further camp information.
