6	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:
7	Section 1. It is hereby declared to be the policy of the City of Topeka that all public
8	records which are made, maintained or kept by or are in the possession of the City, its
9	officers and employees, shall be open for public inspection as provided by, and subject to
10	the restrictions imposed by, the Kansas Open Records Act (K.S.A. 45-215 et seq.).
11	Section 2. Any person, upon request, shall have access to such open public
12	records for the purpose of inspecting, abstracting or copying such records while they are
13	in the possession, custody and control of the appointed or designated record custodian,
1	or the designee.
15	Section 3. The record custodian appointed and designated pursuant to Ordinance
16	No. 17171 shall preserve and protect all public records from damage, disorganization and
17	theft and shall assist, in a timely and efficient manner, any person requesting access to any
18	open public record.
19	Section 4. The City Clerk is the principal recordkeeper of the City and the office of
20	the City Clerk shall be used as the principal office for providing access to and providing
21	copies of open records to the maximum extent practicable.

All City offices keeping and maintaining open public records shall

record. Such hours shall be no fewer than the regular working hours for each day the office maintains regular office hours.

Section 6. Any person requesting access to an open public record for purposes of inspecting or copying such record, or obtaining a copy thereof, shall abide by the procedures adopted by the City Council for record inspection and copying, including those procedures established by the record custodian as authorized by the City Council. Such procedures shall be posted in each City office keeping and maintaining open public records.

Section 7. The record custodian is hereby charged with carrying out the intent of this resolution and the Kansas Open Records Act.

Section 8. City of Topeka Resolution No. 4763 is hereby specifically rescinded.
