Anyone can pitch in the World Horseshoe Tournament. Many first time pitchers become World Class Champions in the lower ringer average classes while more experienced pitchers become World Class Champions in the higher ringer average classes. The two-week world tournament will be held at the Kansas Expocentre to crown class champions and an overall World Champion horseshoe pitcher in each of eight divisions – Men, Women, Senior Men (60+), Senior Women (60+), Elder Men (age 70+), Junior Boys & Girls(13 - 18) and Junior Cadets (12-and under). Pitchers will be competing for approximately \$200,000 in prize money, trophies and scholarships, as well as the right to call themselves “World Class Champion.” Participants will pitch 3 days (approx. 5 games will be played each day). Top qualifiers will advance to the championship round. We are expecting 1500 total entrants from the United States, Canada and several other countries. The last time Kansas hosted the World Horseshoe tournament was in 1909 in Bronson Kansas.

To Qualify:

Step 1

You will need to become a 2015 US State or Canadian provinces Horseshoe Pitchers Association Member by either attending a sanctioned tournament or obtaining the application form off the website.

Step 2

You must compete in a minimum of 4 NHPA sanctioned tournaments prior to May 15 2015 (Juniors/Cadets only 1). All NHPA sanctioned tournaments seed entries by their ringer average so you are always pitching with other folks who have about the same ringer average or skill level as you.

Step 3

Fill out and send in the 2015 World Tournament entry form when it is available on the NHPA web site.

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Kansas Horseshoe Pitchers Association
National Horseshoe Pitchers Association

The NHPA card is a combination membership of the state and the national horseshoe pitching associations. This card entitles you to participate in NHPA sanctioned play throughout the United States and much of Canada, where ever you meet the requirements of the event. You must pay your dues through the state charter where you maintain legal residence as determined by voting, tax and/or drivers license laws.

Dues are based on the calendar year. New Members may pay next years dues after Oct. 1st of the current year and will be eligible to participate in sanctioned events for the final 3 months of the current year, as well as all of the next year. As a member of the Kansas Charter, you will receive newsletters and a schedule of all sanctioned and some non-sanctioned tournaments for the state.

Your pitching stats from all sanctioned events will be forwarded to the NHPA stats headquarters called NatStats. These stats are updated weekly and can be accessed through the NHPA website. To make all this possible, your NHPA card will have six digits followed by two decimals. Kansas is region 18, followed by four digits, which is your membership number. The two decimals represent the calendar year. The decimal and color of the NHPA card change each year. Your membership number will remain with you as long as you reside in Kansas and continue to maintain your membership. If you ever lose your NHPA card, the charter secretary will issue you a duplicate card free of charge. You need only notify the Sec./Treas.
